- Projects



Gig-Training Program

Short-term assignments that allow you to explore different roles, perform specific skill-based tasks, and help partnering organizations.

Open to all students.

Virtual Internship Program

Gain real-world experience from anywhere in the world, working with companies and organizations in various industries.

Open to sophomores and juniors.

Community Internship Program

Meaningful internship opportunities in nonprofit organizations, governmental agencies, and other community-supporting entities.

Open to FWS students.

Career Pathways Program

Provides campus based training on topics ranging from navigating the workplace, communicating for success, and other professional development topics to help prepare them for campus based jobs.




Dream Resume
