*Open to sophomores and juniors.*

## Community Internship Program

*Meaningful internship opportunities in nonprofit organizations, governmental agencies, and other community-supporting entities.*

*Open to FWS students.*

## Career Pathways Program

*Provides campus based training on topics ranging from navigating the workplace, communicating for success, and other professional development topics to help prepare them for campus based jobs.*

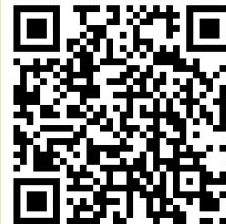

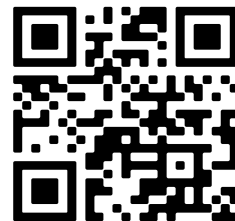
