### **Maximize the Credits You've Earned**

Send official transcripts from every college or university you've attended.

- Before classes begin → send to Undergraduate Admissions
- After classes begin → send to the Office of the Registrar

Earned an Associate Degree from a NC community college?

- Make sure your final transcript shows the degree was awarded
- Example: Associate in Arts awarded on [date]
- General education exemptions can't be granted without this!



### Maximize the Credits You've Earned

Submit test scores (AP, IB, Cambridge, CLEP, etc.)

 Scores must come directly from the testing agency (e.g., College Board)

#### Majoring in a program with a foreign language requirement?

 If you completed 3 levels in high school, send your high school transcript to Admissions

#### Think a course should count differently than listed?

- Talk with your academic advisor
- Use the Academic Petition for Transfer Credit Evaluation or General Education review.
